



## MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES

1. **Approve** – Minutes from May 19<sup>th</sup> membership meeting *Motion to approve May 19, 2022 meeting minutes as presented made by Scott Killinger, seconded by Amy Reis. Motion carried.*
2. **Update – Special Conditions Project 2 in Plainfield**  
*The Village of Plainfield passed a resolution of support for this project in June, an MOU for funding will be completed once Phase 1 part of the project is completed. Hey & Associates and their surveyor will have all of the survey and delineation work done by the end of the week or early next week. Next steps for Hey & Associates:*
  - *Review survey data and begin to investigate concept planning and designs*
  - *Incorporate survey data into H&H modeling*
  - *Develop initial list of improvements to go over with LDRWC*
3. **Update - NIP/NARP**
  - a. *DRSCW is working with Tetra Tech to finalize modeling runs on the Lower DuPage. A meeting will be scheduled with wastewater treatment plant operators in late summer to discuss P removal targets for the NARP.*
  - b. *Illinois River Study Group Meeting notes: Stephen McCracken & Jennifer Hammer went to the Illinois River Study Group meeting this past Tuesday, July 19<sup>th</sup>, at Starved Rock. We presented information on how our work groups formed and are setup. The new group is likely to focus on the Illinois River Watershed from Morris downstream. They will be working on assembling all of the available data, determining whether or not a NARP is the best tool for that part of the watershed and what additional data is needed. They want to make sure that whatever they do downstream will not impact the work of the watershed groups up in our area. They are also not looking for our watershed groups to actually “join” but may ask us for data and information on reductions being made up here. We will continue to watch how things unfold.*
4. **Intro - Will County Program Director** – Tara Neff  
*Tara Neff is the new Will County Program Director for The Conservation Foundation, she shared information about some of TCFs other programs and ways they would like to be working with communities in Will County. She will be reaching out to communities to setup meetings to discuss potential partnerships or assistance that TCF can provide. Her work is meant to complement the work that LDRWC does.*
